Two Arrested in Connection with Lumberton Stabbings

Burlington County Prosecutor Scott Coffina and Lumberton Township Police Chief Anthony DiLoreto announced that a father and son have been charged in connection with two stabbings that occurred Sunday evening during a fight outside of a townhouse on Coriander Drive in Lumberton Township.

Supreme Life, 56, and his son Antoine Ketler, 32, of the first block of Coriander Drive, were each charged with two counts of Aggravated Assault (Second Degree). They will have a first appearance today in Superior Court in Mount Holly.

Police were called to Coriander Drive at 10:40 p.m. Sunday for a report of a stabbing. The investigation revealed that Life and Ketler were involved in a fight during which two men were stabbed. Both victims were transported to Cooper University Hospital in Camden. Moriah Walker, 26, of Brooklyn, was pronounced dead early Monday morning. Raheem Williams, 23, of Queens, is listed in critical but stable condition following surgery.

The investigation into the homicide is ongoing and is being conducted by detectives from the Burlington County Prosecutor's Office and the Lumberton Township Police Department.

All persons are considered innocent until proven guilty in a court of law.
