Moorestown Man Arrested on Child Pornography Charges

Burlington County Prosecutor LaChia L. Bradshaw announced that a 28-year-old Moorestown man has been charged with possession and distribution of Child Sexual Abuse Material (CSAM).

Kevin T. Kramarski was taken into custody at his residence on Wednesday and lodged in the Burlington County Jail in Mount Holly pending a detention hearing next week in Superior Court. The charges against Kramarski include Possession of CSAM with Intent to Distribute (Second Degree), Distribution of CSAM (Second Degree), Possession CSAM (Third Degree) and Contempt of Court (Fourth Degree).

Multiple electronic devices were seized during the execution of a search warrant at his residence and will be analyzed by the BCPO High-Tech Crimes Unit. The case will then be prepared for presentation to a grand jury for possible indictment.

The investigation began after the Prosecutor's Office received information from the National Center for Missing & Exploited Children concerning Kramarski's online activities. Among other things, the investigation revealed that Kramarski actively sought to purchase CSAM online and engaged in online chats with juveniles where he requested that they send him nude photos of themselves.

The investigation was conducted by the Prosecutor's Office, with assistance from the Moorestown Township Police Department. The lead investigator is BCPO Detective Jillian Marin. Kramarski will be prosecuted by the BCPO Special Victims Unit.

The Burlington County Prosecutor's Office is a member of the New Jersey Internet Crimes Against Children Task Force.

All persons are considered innocent until proven guilty in a court of law.
